Over the years, King School students have raised nearly \$80,000.

How does the money help?

If a child has cancer, or some other very serious illness, St. Jude knows that this is a tough time for the whole family. Parents may be worried about how they will be able to pay for their child's treatments.

At St. Jude, no family is ever sent a bill for their child's care. This means they can stop worrying about money, and focus on getting better!
