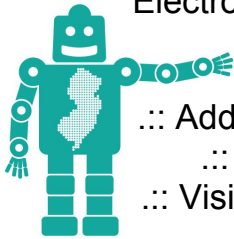
Find us in the field adjacent to the library. Safety Third Racing is a nationally recognized FPV Drone Racing organization.
